# **Dane County Youth Assessment 2024**

## **High School Demographic Report on Race by Selected Items**

The Dane County Youth Commission is pleased to release this Race Report from the 2024 Dane County Youth Assessment (DCYA.) Every three years, youth in grades 7-12 complete the DCYA, which captures their opinions, attitudes, behaviors, and experiences on a range of topics. This report is one in a series of demographic reports the Dane County Youth Commission is publishing that look closely at how certain groups of youth answered selected items from the 2024 DCYA. Different groups of youth often have systematically different perspectives and experiences. Therefore, we believe it is important to take a closer look at how subpopulations of students may respond differently to various topics. The five demographic reports will cover race and ethnicity, gender (including a report broken out by gender identity and a report focusing specifically on youth who identify as transgender), sexual orientation, and family income.

Please note that not all items from the 2024 DCYA are included in this report. ### **Survey Development and Administration**

In 2024, 15,448 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students completed the Dane County Youth Assessment. The 2024 survey was administered between January 15, 2024, and April 15, 2024 to middle and high school students across seventeen public school districts. Student participation was voluntary and anonymous. Parents were notified in advance of survey administration and could opt their child out of participating.

Survey development is led by K12 Associates, LLC and a committee of educators, public health professionals, project funders, and youth interns. The survey includes questions about protective and risk behaviors across contexts of school, peer relations, family, and community. The 2024 DCYA includes new questions on emerging youth issues such as loneliness and social media use, while retaining important questions from past surveys in order to measure trends. The DCYA is a behavioral risk survey that uses self-report methodology. This methodology is widely used and has proven to be valid and reliable. The validity of the assessment is supported by the large survey population, the fact that results are in-line with national trends, and the consistency of the findings over time. The survey includes items from the national Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Youth Risk Behavior Survey and other national surveys to allow for comparisons to youth in the U.S. and in Wisconsin. Extensive efforts are made to ensure that questions are clear and understandable. The survey is available in multiple languages.

The 2024 DCYA marks the eighth time the Youth Commission has coordinated an opportunity for 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade youth in Dane County to voice their opinions, needs, concerns, and interests. This effort provides the community with information and insight on youth trends. Although not the only source of information on what is impacting youth in our community, the DCYA provides one very valuable resource to inform program and policy decisions. The Youth Commission and its partners hope that youth-serving agencies, community stakeholders, parents, policy makers, school districts, and youth will use this and subsequent reports to appreciate where we have been, to recognize the successes and challenges of today, and to create an even brighter future for Dane County. The DCYA is a collaborative effort led by the Dane County Youth Commission in partnership with the United Way of Dane County, Public Health Madison & Dane County, the City of Madison, and school districts in the county. The Youth Commission would like to thank the funding partners, school districts, committee members, and the students and parents of Dane County for making this project possible.

## Using This Report

This report looks at 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students' race by selected questions on the 2024 Dane County Youth Assessment (DCYA-2024). The race question on the DCYA-2024 gave students the option of choosing nine separate race/ethnicity categories. For this report some race categories were combined in an *All Other* category to provide a large enough subgroup to disaggregate.

### 3. What is your race?

The tables in this report are all constructed in the same manner. There are six subgroups: 1) Multi-racial 2) Asian and 3) African-American 4) Hispanic 5) White and 6) All Other. Every table has a column for each subgroup and a column for all 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders (labeled % of All 9th-12th Grade) on DCYA-2024. Each column shows how that group or subgroup responded to the selected question.

In the example below, 39% of students who describe themselves as Hispanic or Latino volunteered and 61% did not. For all 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students 60% volunteered and 40% did not.
